
The ceremony is about 30 minutes in length.

Then turn right on REGINA.

Then a quick left onto LINCOLN HEIGHTS.

About four houses down, and between homes, you will see some greenspace and a footpath leading to woods.

Take the path straight to the end- about 200 steps.

Then turn right- you will see the boulder and plaque in the woods.
